Partners are available to answer your questions about services available locally for your student.

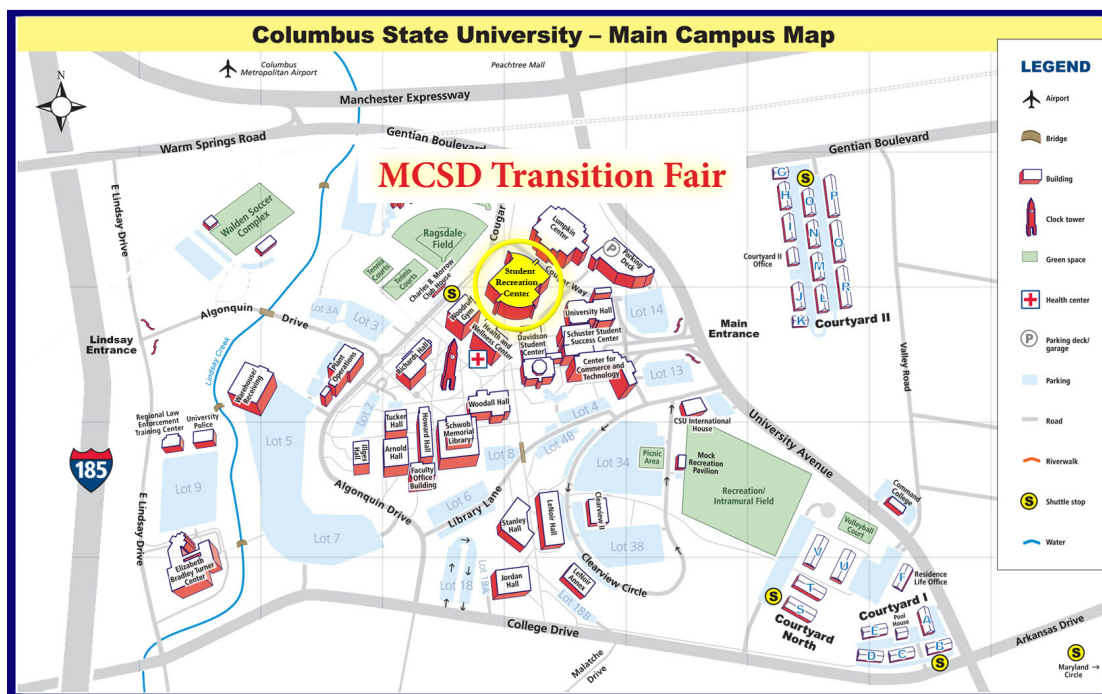
